Summer is here!

We are excited to kick off our summer dance programs, beginning with our "Jazz & Contemporary Workshops" this Thursday and Friday, followed by classes and camps that start on Monday, June 14th!

<u>Updates to DXP COVID measures</u>

As the CDC and local guidelines continue to adjust, we continue to review our mask and distancing policies. Our top priority is the safety and health of our dancers, staff and dance families. We will be making adjustments in layers as the next few months unfold and we continue to evaluate the safety measures needed.

Policies as of Thursday, June 10:

- Masks are optional but highly encouraged for dancers.
- Staff will remain masked.
- **Temperatures** will continue to be taken at the door.
- **Distancing** will still take place within the classroom.
- **Deep sanitizing**, air purification and thorough cleaning will continue to take place regularly throughout the studio.
- Parents may enter the building for drop-off (primarily for our youngest dancers).
- Parents will wait outside for pick-up dancers will remain in the lobby and will be released at the door to their respective guardian.

Drop off in-person!

Starting Thursday, June 10, one adult guardian will be able to enter the building to drop off their dancer, see the classroom and meet the teacher!

- Parents will stay in the lobby and the kids will walk themselves into the actual studio room.
- Once the dancer is settled into the room, we kindly ask that parents exit the building.
- This is primarily for our youngest and newest dancers. Our goal is for parents to stay at the front door during drop-off whenever possible.

We ask that parents wait outside for pick-up at the conclusion of class/camp/workshop.

Watch class via Zoom later this Summer!

At this stage, due to space constraints and distancing measures, we're currently unable to congregate in the lobby. However, we will have opportunities to watch your dancer's class via

Zoom this summer!

We will send the dates and details very soon. We are not doing Zoom for at least the 1st week of classes so we can focus on getting the kids into their class routine. Having parents on Zoom has the potential to distract the kids in class, especially our youngest and newest dancers. \bigcirc
